**TO ENTER:**

- 1) You must request an Entry number if you did not request one from the RYT benefit show by e-mailing [cmbndtrng@gmail.com](mailto:cmbndtrng@gmail.com).
- 2) Entry forms must be e-mailed to [cmbndtrng@gmail.com](mailto:cmbndtrng@gmail.com) Only 1 Entry per form, which means 1 horse per form, not 2 or 3.
- 3) Payment to the "friends and family" option of paypal to [cmbndtrng@gmail.com](mailto:cmbndtrng@gmail.com).
- 4) Videos to be posted under the album of each class in the comments. Please do not e-mail me the videos unless you have privacy concerns, and in that case we need to discuss how they will be sent in order for the judge to also be sent your videos. The very best way to post your video is to upload it to youtube. Your video can be "unlisted" and post the link in the album comments. When posting your video include your entry number, your name and horse's name.

No refunds, please consider it a donation. Judge's decision is final. This is a fun show and 100% done by volunteers!

Standing martingales allowed in all over fences class. Tie downs allowed in barrels. Leg wraps and bell boots allowed except in trail and in-hand classes. USEF, USDF, WDAA, and AQHA rules. Bitless bridles allowed. Show clothing not required, but please dress neatly. Horses can be fuzzy and no need to braid or band.

Beginners MAY cross-enter Open walk-trot-jog. Mini and VSE classes open to equines 12hands and under.

While videoing, please film horizontally. Make sure to show the entire horse in the in-hand and do not cut off the hooves, etc. Please be aware of backlighting and pixilation. The judge cannot judge what they cannot see.

Sound MUST be ON for Dressage and Trail videos, as hearing the ride is imperative. Always video Dressage from C.

Videos Taken from Dec 1, 2020 -current are eligible. Video must have date listed either directly on the video, shown with a phone, or on a piece of paper. Videos may be used more than once if appropriate. Only paid entries will be judged. Videos to be posted on The Facebook Group "Virtual Horse Show Fundraiser for Horse Amour." Go into albums, and post your videos in the comment of your class album. Make sure to look at the Gait calls in these albums BEFORE filming!

ASTM/SEI approved Helmets are required by ALL riders/drivers 18 and under and MUST be worn in jumping classes by all ages.

\$8 per class. Awards are small ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place in each class. Rosettes for Champion and Reserve. Must enter a minimum of 3 classes per division to be eligible for Championship. Ribbons will be ordered directly following the show and mailed out. \$5 mailing/office fee for US residents and \$10 mailing/office fee for Canadian residents. Again, this is a fundraiser, and we want to do the most we can to help Horse Amour!

**Exceptional Riders** are any riders with a physical disability. This is on the honor system. Side walkers allowed. Riders may be on a lead if needed. Flexibility in tack allowed given the needs of horse/rider. We fully support Exceptional Riders! Helmets required in all Exceptional rider classes.

**Barrels** need to be measured exactly. There is a diagram in the patterns. Please start and end the timer on a line 20 feet from the first barrel. You must show the clock starting and stopping on a stopwatch or phone with very clear view of final time. Must show video of the run.

**Freestyles** judged on creativity, execution, degree of difficulty, suitability of music. Must meet minimum requirements.
